Resource Fair

Community Policing Training & Strategy Overview

The University of Chicago Police Department will introduce the SARA (Scanning, Analysis, Response, and Assessment) model, a familiar process for initiating problem-oriented policing (POP). The SARA model will be detailed and applied to one or two common problems in our community.
